There is a large open plan tiled lounge room big enough to fit any sized lounge. The good sized separate dining room is adjacent to the kitchen with ample cupboard space, dishwasher, a great sized pantry and breakfast bar.

A family bathroom has a separate shower and bath and a decent sized vanity. The adjacent laundry gives ample room for the weekly chore and provides easy access to the back yard.
